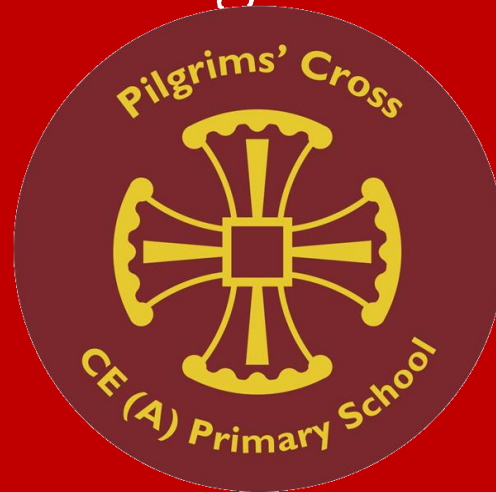

Parents' responsibilities...

1. Show an interest in the children's learning adventures.
2. Read everyday with your child.
3. Check children's book bag.
4. Read all letters, texts or emails from school and respond appropriately.
5. Support child to complete home-learning activities.
6. Attend school meetings and information sessions.
7. Ensure child attends school on time and regularly.
8. Be a role model for their children by demonstrating good behaviour, positive attitude to learning and respecting others.
9. Inform school of any changes to home life.
10. Ensure children attend school in the correct uniform and have the correct items in school (e.g. PE kit)
11. Support the school's vision and help the children develop and understand how to live out the school values... LOVE, COURAGE and TRUST.

Children's responsibilities ...

1. Always show LOVE, COURAGE and TRUST
2. Be respectful to everyone
3. Try their best
4. Do their home-learning with support from their parent(s).
5. Be proud of their talents
6. Be organised with respect to their age.
7. Ask for help if they are stuck
8. Tell a grown-up if someone has been unkind to them

School's responsibilities...

2. Ensure the school spends their budget correctly and ensure good value for money.
3. Challenge and support the leadership team in the best interests of the children.
4. Ensure the school adheres to its statutory duties, including safeguarding and health and safety.
