Pilgrims' Cross Primary School will:

Provide a safe, positive, nurturing environment in which your child can thrive;

Recognise your child as an individual and celebrate their successes both inside and outside school;

Encourage your child to be **Loving, Courageous** and **Trustworthy** through regular promotion of the Pilgrims' Cross Citizenship Values;

Help equip your child with the knowledge and skills needed for transition to the next year group/secondary school and, ultimately, to enable them to become *positive role-models* in society as they grow up;

Provide a rich, engaging and broad curriculum which encourages your child to ask questions and develop a love of learning;

Offer learning opportunities that provide the correct level of support and challenge to enable your child to make good progress and attain highly;

Provide you with information relating to your child's curriculum including class celebrations and regular parent/carer appointments;

Keep you regularly informed of your child's progress through day-to-day conversations, meetings and written reports.

As a Parent/Carer I will:

Ensure my child attends school every day on time (the school day starts at 8.20am) wearing school uniform and equipped, as set out in our Uniform Policy;

Ensure, as much as possible, that my child is physically ready for school, has had a good night's sleep & has had breakfast (excl. children attending Breakfast Club);

Notify the school immediately if my child is to be absent from school for any reason;

Ensure that my child only brings fruit or a healthy snack as a break time snack (a fruit snack is provided for children in Early Years and Key Stage 1);

Support the promotion of the Pilgrims' Cross values of **Love, Courage** and **Trust**;

Support my child to complete home learning to a high standard. This includes **regularly hearing my child read** (and commenting in their Learning Journal), practising spellings or completing maths activities;

Work openly and honestly in partnership with my child's teacher to keep them informed of any circumstances outside school which may affect my child's learning;

Attend meetings (remote or face-to-face) to discuss my child's learning and progress and regularly check the school website/newsletter for information about key dates/events, curriculum and home learning;

Work collaboratively and constructively with the school and raise any concerns directly with my child's class teacher in the first instance and, if not resolved, then with the Headteacher;

Maintain a kind and respectful attitude in all communications with or about the school (pupils, staff and governors), including those made in person, in writing and or via social media;

Make arrangements for the safe collection of my child at the end of the school day (2.50pm) or after an extra-curricular activity and notify the school of these arrangements.
